She is very sad to be leaving the school, but this is a wonderful opportunity for her and her family and we wish her every success in the future. Since joining the school, she has become a very highly-regarded and valued member of the teaching team, as well as a fantastic teacher for our Year 2 class. She has worked hard to develop and embed our new curriculum for Spanish and to support teachers in delivering it. I would like to thank her for the excellent work that she has done to support the whole school and to say that she will be very much missed.

Ms Waiyaki, who teaches our Reception class for three days a week, will be leaving us to support her son who will be starting school in September. She has been a wonderful Reception teacher and has given a great deal of support to Mrs Sorbello-Bali and Ms Ishaque, as well as to the rest of the Reception class team. We wish her every happiness in the future.

I would like to thank them both for their hard work and for all that they have done to support the children in their classes and across the school. I'm sure that you will want to join me in wishing them much-deserved happiness and every success for the future.
