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School Uniform Policy St Augustine's Federated Schools: Primary

Please ensure that your child is coming to school in the correct uniform. Please refer to the uniform policy below.

<p>Nursery Pupils</p> <p>All year</p>	<p>Children in our Nursery do not wear a uniform. However, it is very important that they come to school in comfortable clothes that enable them to run, jump, climb and move around easily. It is also important that children wear clothes that you do not mind getting a bit messy with paint, glue etc. We also ask you to dress children appropriately for the weather. For example, on a wet or snowy day it would help to send children in with a pair of Wellington boots to change into.</p>

<p>Key Stage 2 Pupils</p> <p>Years</p> <p>3, 4, 5 & 6</p>	<p>Autumn and Winter Terms (September – April)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White long OR short-sleeved shirt with collar • St Augustine's school tie (not elasticated) • Navy blue v-neck woollen jumper or cardigan (no sweatshirts) • Long grey trousers OR grey knee-length pinafore dress OR grey knee-length skirt • Plain navy blue, black or white headscarf/hijab (no patterns or decorations) • Flat shoes or trainers – must be ALL black, no high heels 	<p>Summer Term (May – July)</p> <p>As Autumn and Winter terms OR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White polo shirt with long or short sleeves (no tie) • Grey shorts or a light blue or dark blue checked knee-length summer dress* (no stripes) <p>Black, navy blue or white sandals – not open toe, feet must be fully strapped in</p>

* **Please note:** we do not allow any leggings ‘hanging-out’ from below the summer dress, or long-sleeved tops with ‘arms’ that come out underneath the shorter-sleeve of a polo shirt or summer dress. If it is important to you that your child’s arms and legs are fully covered, then it would be best to keep them wearing long grey trousers or a grey knee-length skirt with tights and a long-sleeved white shirt or long-sleeved white polo shirt.

- **Coats/Jackets:** Please ensure your child wears some kind of waterproof coat or jacket to school on every potentially cool or wet day as we will have playtime and lunchtime outside whenever possible, even in cold weather and light rain. We would prefer your child’s coat to be plain navy blue or black or a plain dark colour. We sell suitable jackets in the school office.
- **Earrings:** If your child wears earrings, **only** plain gold or silver studs may be worn – no shapes or designs. No other jewellery is allowed, except for watches.
- **Hair:** Any child with long hair must keep it tied back neatly. Hair ties must be **plain** black, grey, navy blue or white (no patterns except in summer when a light or dark blue checked hair tie may be used to match the summer dress). Mohican hairstyles and/or writing or patterns cut into hair are **not** allowed.
- **Hijab:** If your child wears a headscarf/hijab for religious observance, it must be **plain** black, navy blue or white (no patterns).
- **Hooded Sweatshirts:** ‘Hoodies’ must **not** be worn at **any** time, not even over the top of the uniform instead of a proper coat.
- **Labels:** All clothing **must** be clearly labelled with your child’s name. We sell iron-on name labels in the school office. The school cannot be held responsible for the loss of any clothing, especially when it is not named.
- **Wellington Boots:** On very wet and snowy days you may send your child to school in Wellington boots, but you must also send a pair of black shoes/trainers for your child to change into.

P.E. Kit:

For PE All Children Should Wear:

- Plain white polo shirt
- Plain navy-blue sweatshirt (no patterns or stripes)
- Plain navy-blue tracksuit trousers made of sweatshirt material (no patterns or stripes) OR plain navy-blue shorts of mid-thigh to knee length (such as cotton P.E. shorts or football shorts but NOT skin-tight Lycra cycling shorts or shorts above mid-thigh length)
- White or grey socks
- Outside PE - all black trainers. Inside PE – bare feet or plimsols if your child has a verruca

If you would like your child to wear the P.E. kit with the St Augustine’s logo stitching, all of the above can be bought at school. If you prefer, you can buy it without the logo at any shop.

When to bring PE Kit to School:

Reception children must bring their PE kit to school in a bag and keep it in school with them all week. They will be taught how to get changed for P.E. and how to look after their clothes.

Year 1 & 2 children should wear their PE kit to school on the two days each week that they have PE (see class teachers’ newsletters). This will maximise the amount of time spent on PE and minimise loss of clothing.

Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 may wear their PE kit to school on the two days each week that they have PE (see class teachers’ newsletters). This will maximise the amount of time spent on PE and minimise loss of clothing.
